## Softball - Spring Leagues

Men's, Women's and Co-Rec leagues are available. Sixteen separate leagues with various skill and competition levels are played at Round Lake and Lake Riley softball fields beginning the end of April. League fees include softballs and will vary for a 13, 18 or 23 game schedule. Information flyers will be sent to last year's teams in January. Returning Team registration is in mid-February. Returning teams that have not registered by the deadline will lose their returning team status. New team registration is in early-March or until filled. A mandatory new team meeting is held in March. ## Doubles Bocce League

Bocce is played with eight large balls (four balls to a team) and one small target ball. The object of the game is to get your balls closer to the target ball than your opponent by rolling, throwing, bouncing, or banking your ball. League play is on Tuesday or Wednesday evenings beginning in June at Staring Lake Park. The league fee is charged per team (2 people per team). The registration deadline is in May.

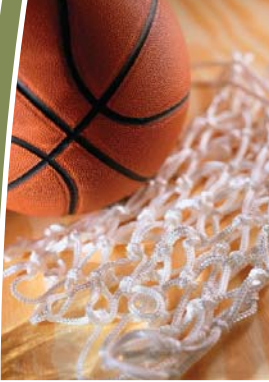
Eden Prairie Adult Athletics are open to adult (age 19 and up) men and women who live or work in Eden Prairie. Sixty percent of your teams' participants must live or work in Eden Prairie. Teams consisting of 100% Eden Prairie residents will have priority if the league is full. To register a team, complete a registration form and pay the team fee in person or through the mail before the deadline.

If you are an individual and you would like to be placed on a team, call a week after the registration deadline to find out which teams may need more players.

## **Volleyball – Spring Leagues**

Men's, Women's and Co-Rec leagues are available. Officiated games are played at Central Middle School and Oak Point Intermediate School from March through mid-May. Co-Rec Leagues are for men and women with special rules that make it more enjoyable for everyone. Games are played on Monday evenings. Women's Leagues are offered in both upper and lower divisions. Officiated matches are played on Tuesday evenings. Men's Leagues are offered in upper, middle and lower divisions offered. Officiated matches will include multiple weeks of double-headers played on Thursday evenings.

## **Kickball League**

Co-Rec Kickball Leagues are for men and women with special rules that make it enjoyable for everyone. Games are played for seven weeks on Monday and/or Thursday evenings beginning in June. Each team consists of ten players (at least five must be female) on the field at one time. Games will be played at local ballfields or at ballfields in Hopkins. The registration deadline is mid-April.

## **Basketball – Summer League**

Outdoor 3 on 3 Basketball will be offered at Round Lake Park on Tuesday evenings with six weeks of league play and two weeks of playoffs. Two separate divisions (upper-competitive and lower recreational) will be offered beginning in June. The registration deadline is in May.

## **Football**

4-Man Touch Football League games are played on Wednesday nights from mid-August through October. Registration forms will be sent to all new and returning teams. Call 952-949-8438 to get on the mailing list if you have a new team. The registration deadline is in July.

## **Sand Volleyball**

The Co-Rec Sand Volleyball Leagues play for twelve weeks beginning in June. The officiated games are played at Lake Riley or Round Lake Parks. The Open 4's Leagues have two divisions (upper and intermediate) and play on Tuesday evenings. The Open 6's Leagues have three divisions (beginners, intermediate and advanced) and play on Monday or Wednesday evenings. The Womens League has two divisions and plays on Thursday evenings. The registration deadline is in May.

## **Softball - Fall Leagues**

Men's, Women's and Co-Rec leagues are available. Games are played at Round Lake softball fields Monday through Friday evenings and Sundays. League fees vary for a 7, 10 or 13 game schedule and include softballs. Information flyers will be sent to last year's teams and the spring teams. The registration deadline is in July.

## **Basketball – Fall/Winter League**

Games are played at Central Middle School on Wednesday evenings. The registration deadline is early September. Both a Men's 3 on 3 Basketball League and a Women's 3 on 3 Basketball League are offered with upper and lower divisions. The half-court and unofficiated games are played for 40 minutes beginning mid-September. The Men's 5 on 5 Basketball League has high, middle, and lower level divisions. Teams can register to play full-court basketball on Wednesday evenings for sixteen weeks from the end of October through February.

## **Volleyball – Fall Leagues**

Men's, Women's and Co-Rec leagues are available. Officiated games are played at Central Middle School and Oak Point Intermediate School from mid-September through mid-December. The registration deadline is in September. Co-Rec Leagues are for men and women with special rules that make it more enjoyable for everyone. Seven separate levels of play are available from beginner level of play to advance. Games are played on Monday evenings. Women's Leagues are offered in both upper and lower divisions. Fifteen officiated matches are played on Tuesday evenings beginning in October. Men's Leagues are offered in upper, middle and lower divisions offered. ## **Flag Football**

4-Man Flag Football games are played on Wednesday nights in November and December at the Eden Prairie High School Dome (55° and no wind or rain). The registration deadline is in September.



## **Volleyball – Winter Leagues**

Co-Rec Leagues are for men and women with special rules that make it more enjoyable for everyone. Seven separate levels of play are available from beginner level of play to advanced. Games are played on Monday evenings. Officiated games are played at Eden Lake Elementary School, Central Middle School and Oak Point Intermediate School. The twelve match schedule begins in January and continues through March. The registration deadline is in December.

## **Broomball**

Broomball is similar to hockey, but the players use broomball sticks, a ball and wear shoes. Seven weeks of officiated outdoor play begins in December at the Round Lake Park hockey rinks. All games are officiated. Championship games are played at the end of the season. Registration deadline is in early-December. Co-Rec Broomball Leagues are played on Wednesday evenings. The Men's Broomball League (six-man, no-check, red-line) plays on Tuesday evenings.

## **Racquetball**

Racquetball League registration is offered each season. There is one Open Division for players in A and B levels. Pairings and contact persons are arranged. Players book and pay for Community Center court time and supply game ball. Each match involves three 15-point games. The \$5 league fee includes awards. For more information call 952-949-8471.
